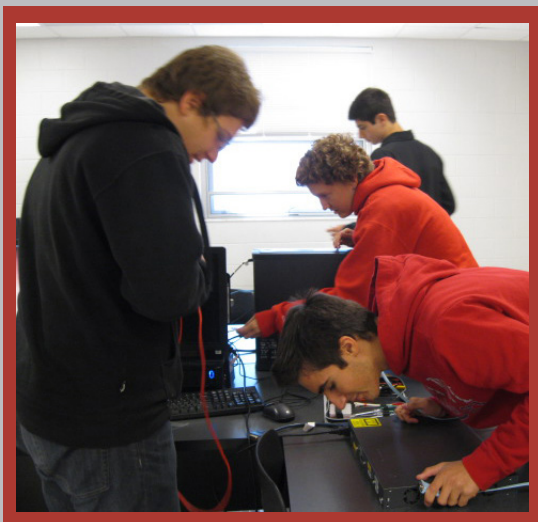


EMERGING TECHNOLOGY
