CSL Venus Manly Scholarship

For St. Johns County high school seniors with disabilities graduating in May 2019

Members of the Center for Spiritual Living (CSL) St Augustine recognizes the need for continuing education for young adults with disabilities who graduate from high school. Also acknowledging the high cost of education and some of the financial needs of our community, we offer a scholarship for St. Johns County graduating seniors who plan to attend a College, University, Trade or Technical School.

Continuing in our second year, CSL will offer the Venus Manly scholarship named for a member of the St. Augustine Center who was disabled with cerebral palsy and transitioned early in her young life at age 14. We want to encourage students with disabilities to write about how they have overcome their specific challenges and to reflect on what they can see themselves accomplishing in their future. We invite graduating seniors to share their ideas in an essay about their plans on how they will make the world a better place through their education. They will present these ideas during a committee interview to compete to win one of three \$1,000 scholarships.

This scholarship contest will assess the student's writing and presentation skills. We will allow the use of accommodations while completing the application and essay.

The CSL scholarship committee will score the essay and issue invitations to ten (10) semi-finalists to make an in-person interview. A combination of the highest scores of the applicant's submission of Part 1 and 2 will determine the scholarship recipients.

Part 1. An essay due by March 31, 2019.

Answer the following question in 500 words or less (min: 250 words).

"How have you overcome your specific challenges and what do you see yourself accomplishing through your education?"

Part 2. An Interview of semi-finalists will take place before April 30th, 2019.

Examples of questions:

1. What are your post-secondary education plans after high school?
2. What have you done in high school to prepare for this post-secondary experience?
3. How do you plan to merge your experiences as a high school student from St. Johns County Florida with your future education and career?

CSL will award the scholarships before May 10, 2019.
