- ▶ **1 Online Course**

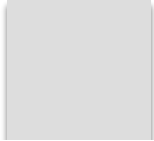
- ▶ Students must earn a 2.0 grade

Grade Forgiveness

- ▶ Students may earn forgiveness for classes that they have a D or an F by taking a virtual school class
 - ▶ PLATO – a computer program used to retake a class where you earned failing grades. Classes are taken here at Creekside during the school day.
 - ▶ You can take a class for grade forgiveness online over the summer but be aware it may take longer than you think!
