Students become part of a "school body" within their school to connect about subjects they enjoy.

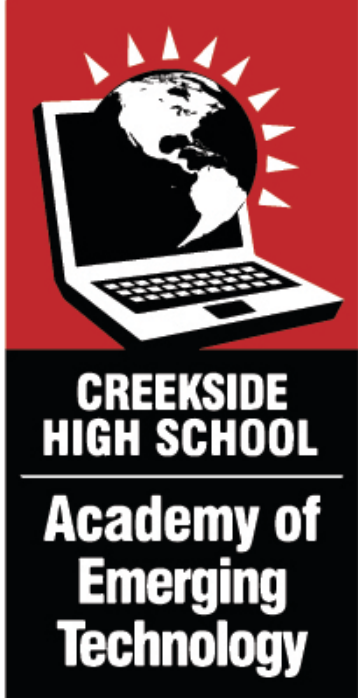

Students will learn several Adobe Creative Cloud desktop apps that include skills in web design, vector graphics and illustration, photo editing, video editing, publication layout and more.

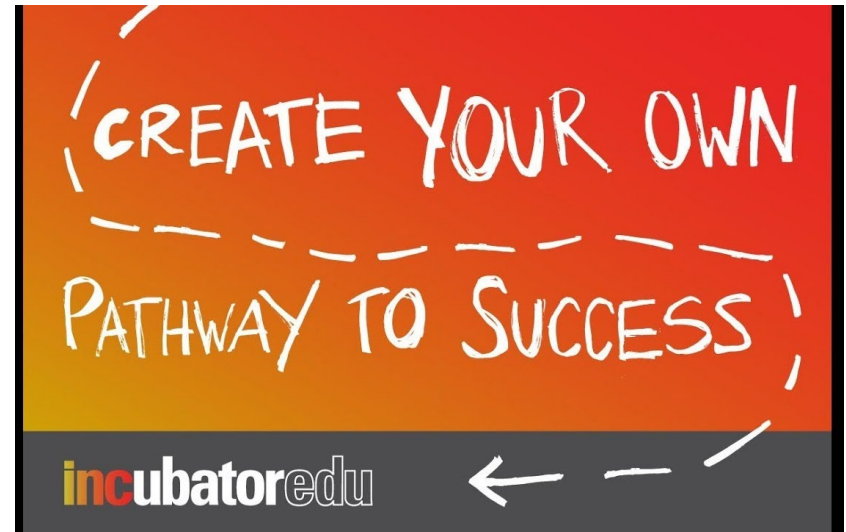
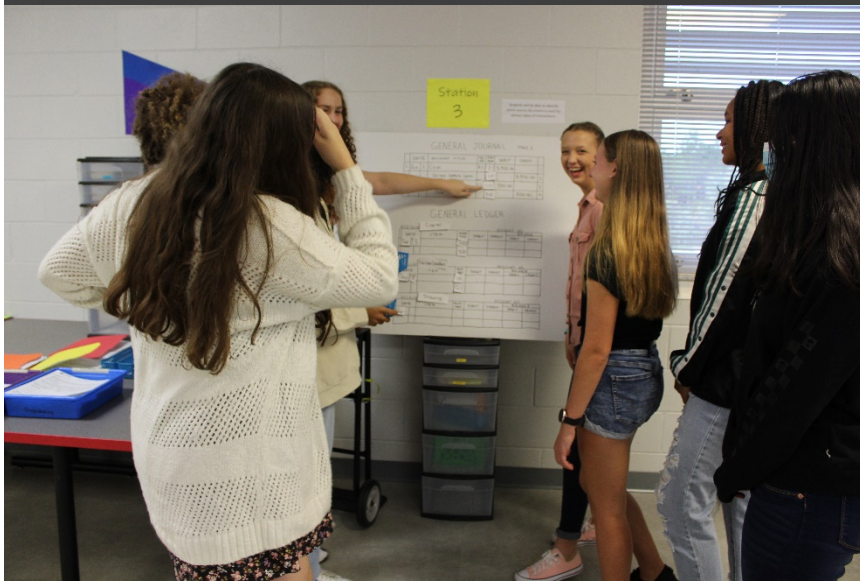




# Cybersecurity

# Environmental Science

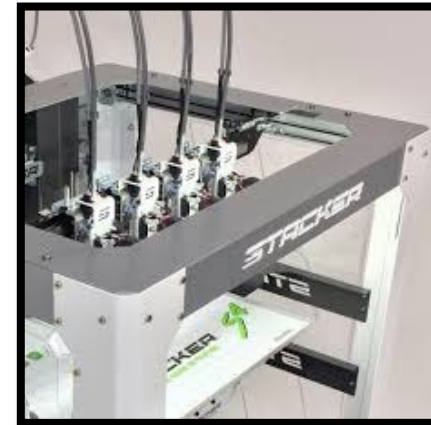
Students will study ecosystem awareness, water quality, air quality, managing hazardous materials, green building technologies, forests and wetlands management, as well as Environmental Legislation.

Congratulations to the Creekside High School Cyber Patriots team, TORtured Onions, for placing 1st in the state.


**Girls Volleyball District Champions**
