- Applicant must have a clean disciplinary history as determined by evaluators. Include a copy of high school discipline report.
- A resume detailing club involvement and volunteer experience.

Submit all requirements to School Counselor to **<u>BY April 1, 2020</u>** to be forwarded for evaluation by the Jack Hamilton Wheeler Memorial Scholarship Committee.
