## Creekside High School Junior Modified Schedule Form 2021-2022 School Year



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The St. Johns County School Board has approved procedures that will allow juniors who have met or is on track to meet all graduation requirements and conditions to choose a modified course schedule.

## **Abbreviated Course Schedule Requirements:**

- 1. The student MUST declare his/her intention to take a modified course schedule at the time of registration for his/her final year of high school. The student must be enrolled in 4 or more AP or Dual Enrollment classes to qualify.
- 2. It will be the responsibility of the student whose schedule has been modified to obtain information about junior activities.
- 3. The student will still be able to qualify for the Florida Bright Futures Scholarships if he/she meets the criteria for the scholarship before graduation.
- 4. The student's schedule will have 6 classes and modified 1<sup>st</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> period only. We cannot give a choice as to period. It is based upon the rest of the classes that you choose. We may not be able to change from 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> or vice versa after the schedule is built.
- 5. The student's schedule will not be changed to reduce instruction time once school starts.
- 6. Having a modified schedule is a privilege. A student's schedule may be changed to eliminate the modified schedule due to academic or behavior concerns.
- 7. The district assumes no obligation or responsibility for transportation difficulties generated by the decision to follow a modified schedule. Students must not be on campus when they are not scheduled for a class. Continual violation of this will result in removal of the modified period.
- 8. The student must have his/her own transportation and be off campus during the modified schedule time.

## **Graduation Requirements for All Students:**

- 1. A 2.0 <u>unweighted</u> grade point average must be earned at the end of all course work.
- 2. Required state testing for graduation requirements.
- 3. Must have all required freshman and sophomore credits.
