Once applicants have submitted the application and uploaded or mailed the additional required documents, including two letters of recommendation, the application is complete.

Applications will be reviewed by the SJR State Foundation, with final selections announced in early summer for the next academic year. Selected applicants will receive a scholarship award packet and will be asked to sign a certification letter by the deadline noted in the packet. All scholarship monies are disbursed via the students' financial aid account after the completed packet has been returned.
