- Attend one Virtual Student/Parent Orientation Session- Saturday, June 3rd at 10 AM <u>OR</u> Thursday, June 8th at 7 PM
- Attend all mentoring workshops (June and July dates will be announced during Orientation)
- Attend the 50 Stars Gala-September 8, 2023, and the Gala Rehearsal (TBA)
