The St. Johns County School Board has approved procedures that will allow seniors who have met or is on track to meet all graduation requirements and conditions to choose a modified course schedule.

## Abbreviated Course Schedule Requirements:

- 1. The student MUST declare his/her intention to take a modified course schedule at the time of registration for his/her final year of high school.
- 2. It will be the responsibility of the student whose schedule has been modified to obtain information about graduation activities, senior activities, scholarships, etc.
  - 3. The student will still be able to qualify for the Florida Bright Futures Scholarships if he/she meets the criteria for the scholarship before graduation.
- 4. The senior schedule will have at least 3 classes. We cannot give a choice as to morning or afternoon modified. It is based upon the rest of the classes that you choose. Core classes will take priority over a modified schedule.
- 5. The student's schedule will not be changed to reduce instruction time once school starts.
- 6. Having a modified schedule is a privilege. A student's schedule may be changed to eliminate the modified due to academic concerns, including progress in virtual courses
- 7. The district assumes no obligation or responsibility for transportation difficulties generated by the decision to follow a modified schedule. Students must not be on campus when they are not scheduled for a class. Continual violation of this will result in removal of the modified period.
- 8. The student must have his/her own transportation and be off campus during the modified schedule time.

## **Senior Modification Requirements:**

- 1. A 2.0 unweighted grade point average must be earned at the end of all course work
- 2. Pass required state testing graduation requirements (i.e. Algebra, ELA).
- 3. Must have all required freshman, sophomore, and junior credits.
