TESTING NEWS

2021 PSAT Date: October 13th

The purpose of the test is to give all students an opportunity to experience taking a college readiness test and to identify students who might benefit from advanced coursework.

- Students in 9th and 11th grade must pay a \$22 registration fee in order to take the test and receive their scores.
- Registration fee payment can be made online through SchoolPay
- Click Here to Pay for the PSAT!
- The last day to pay for registration is Sunday, September 12 at 11:59p.m.

All 10th grade students will take the test and receive a score report at no charge.

Your student's Score Report for the PSAT/NMSQT® will be available in mid-to-late December from College Board.

Specific test information and locations will be provided closer to the test date.

Please note: Students will receive an Official Student Guide to the PSAT/ NMSQT® through their English classes. This guide contains valuable information as well as a full-length practice test with answer keys. Please visit <u>www.collegeboard.org/psat</u> for more information.
