#### <u>Information on Early Dismissal & Excused Absences:</u>

## TESTING INFORMATION: ACT COLLEGE REPORTABLE - MARCH 1ST

On March 1<sup>St</sup>, all juniors enrolled at Creekside High School will have the opportunity to take the ACT College Reportable, an important test that provides many benefits that can help them along the path to college. If your student is a junior, the ACT offers them the opportunity to take the ACT during the regular school day at no cost to you. No registration is required by you or your student.

The ACT test scores will provide you with information about your student's progress toward colleges in making decisions about admission. Students who take the ACT will be able to share their ACT scores with colleges and universities. The ACT test can also give students concordant scores for Algebra 1/Geometry EOC (score of 16+) and/or FSA ELA Writing/Reading (average score of 18 on the Reading and English subtests).






