Dual Enrollment:

Spring 2022 DUAL ENROLLMENT at SJRSC (this includes classes at the college as well as online classes, It does not include DE classes at Creekside)- DEADLINE TO ENROLL IS 11/30 AT 12:00 NOON

Are you interested in taking Spring dual enrollment classes at SJRSC? Interested students can take up to 10 credits hours as a part-time DE student or go full-time (SENIORS ONLY) and take 12-16 credit hours (students would not take any classes at Creekside as a full-time DE student). Please be careful of the dates/times if you choose a live online class.

If you are new to Dual Enrollment (meaning are currently NOT taking any DE courses or are not registered for any Fall DE courses at Creekside), you will need to complete the following:

- 1. Online application and submit consent form (Please CHS guidance Schoology for link)
- 2. Official SAT, ACT or PERT test scores (Please see CHS guidance Schoology for PERT Flyer)
- 3. Spring Registration form (Please see CHS guidance Schoology for registration form)

If you are a returning student to Dual Enrollment (took a DE course either at the college or at Creekside during the Fall 2021 term), you will need to complete the following:

- 1. Submit official SAT, ACT or PERT scores, only if you plan to take a Math class
- 2. Spring Registration form (Please see CHS guidance Schoology for registration form)

Spring 2022 Dual Enrollment Registration deadline is November 30, 2021 at 12:00 NOON. All fall forms should be submitted to Ms. Fornera via Schoology or email <u>jennifer.fornera@stjohns.k12.fl.us</u> OR students may drop off all forms to my office in the guidance area, room 111. If emailing or sending via Schoology, please make sure forms are sent as an attachment and not in the body of the email.

If you have any questions please send me a message on Schoology, email or stop by and see me in my office.

Keep in mind classes at the college site, close fast. The sooner you submit your registration form, the better. Also, if you attend Creekside and plan to take DE classes at the college site for Spring term, please make sure the classes you choose at the college, do not conflict with your CHS schedule. WE WILL NOT CHANGE YOUR CHS SCHEUDLE TO ACCOMMODATE YOUR SJRSC SCHEUDLE FOR THE SPRING TERM.
