Prescription medication/forms drop-off in the clinic:

- All prescription medications **MUST** be brought in the original, labeled pharmacy container and **MUST BE** brought in by an adult (not by the student).

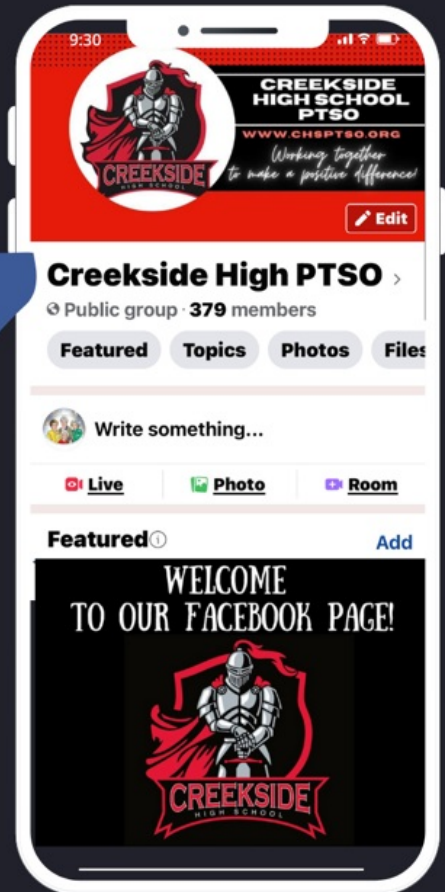
