PSAT Registration & Payment INFORMATION

2022 PSAT Date: October 12th, 2022

PSAT is an indicator or performance on SAT and AP readiness; it provides students with a chance to check in on progress toward college and career readiness and success. It is the only way for juniors to qualify for National Merit Scholarship! As a reminder, the PSAT is for ALL 10th grade students as well as any 9th or 11th grade students who register and pay to take the exam. Students in 9th and 11th grade must pay a \$22 registration fee to take the test and receive their scores. **REGISTRATION CLOSES ON SEPTEMBER 11**TH AT 11:59P.M.

All 10th grade students will take the test and receive a score report at no charge.


