2025 STATE-FUNDED ACT COLLEGE REPORTABLE FOR JUNIORS

ABOUT THE TEST:

On Tuesday, February 25^{th,} 2025, all 11th-grade students will have the opportunity to take a college reportable ACT, an important test that provides many benefits that can help them along the path to college. If your student is in 11th-grade, they will automatically be registered by the school district. The ACT scores will inform you about your student's progress toward colleges in making admission decisions. Students who take the ACT will be able to share their ACT scores with colleges and universities. The ACT can also give students concordant scores for Algebra 1/Geometry EOC (score of 16+) and/or FSA ELA Writing/Reading (average score of 18 on the Reading and English subtests). *You can access ACT preparation resources here:* ACT Test Prep.

TEST DAY INFORMATION

WHAT TO BRING ON TEST DAY:

- School ID, pencils, calculator, water, and a snack.
- Calculators will not be provided; however, all questions can be answered without one if you forget to bring one. Please visit ACT Calculator Policy to view the completed calculator policy.
- There is a *strict* **NO** cell phone, earbuds, or smartwatch policy.

On test day, students will need to have and know the following information:

- Complete home address, including zip code
- Email address
- Date of birth

PRE-TEST INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS:

All 11th-grade students will receive Non-Test Information to complete for receiving and sending their scores which must be done before the test date. They will receive this information from their English teacher. If they are not enrolled in English at Creekside, another teacher will provide the information packet. TESTING LOCATIONS:

Students will test in assigned testing rooms organized by last name. Signs will be posted around campus and testing locations will be posted on the Creekside Testing Website: <u>11th-grade College Reportable</u> <u>ACT School Day</u>.

DISMISSAL ON TEST DAY:

For Juniors who drive and would like to leave campus immediately after the testing has concluded, *parents need to complete the* 2025 Junior ACT Test Day- Early Release Form for Tuesday, February 25th *by* 11:45 *pm by Friday, February* 21st, 2025.

9TH, 10TH & 12TH GRADE INFORMATION:

This state-funded ACT College Reportable test is **only** available for Juniors on February 25^{th,} 2025. All 9th, 10th, and 12th graders will be allowed an at-home learning day. To ensure an optimal testing environment, we will allow flexibility to students on this day. High school students not participating in the ACT College Reportable test may complete assigned work from home or at school on this day. Teachers will communicate expectations online that day. Students who report to school that day will be held in the auditorium for a study hall and provided lunch once all testing has concluded. Assigned work will be due on Wednesday, February 26th, 2025, the day after the exam.
