Tips for a Successful Testing Session

- **Be prepared** – review materials and know your exam schedule.
- **Get plenty of rest** – a good night's sleep is crucial for focus.
- **Eat a healthy breakfast** – fuel your brain for optimal performance.
- **Arrive on time** – lateness could impact your ability to take the test.
- **Bring essential supplies** – two #2 sharpened pencils with a good eraser.
- **Avoid scheduling appointments during testing** – if a student is checked out during a test, the exam will be invalidated.

Senior AP Exam Early Release or Late Arrival

- Seniors who wish to leave early or arrive late on an AP exam day must **complete the following form by Monday, April 29th**:

- Eligible students will receive early dismissal from a proctor at the end of their AP exam. **This option is available only for seniors who do not have 15 or more total absences.**
