▼ Tips for a Successful Testing Session

- Be prepared review materials and know your exam schedule.
- Get plenty of rest a good night's sleep is crucial for focus.
- Eat a healthy breakfast fuel your brain for optimal performance.
- Arrive on time lateness could impact your ability to take the test.
- Bring essential supplies two #2 sharpened pencils with a good eraser.
- Avoid scheduling appointments during testing if a student is checked out during a test, the exam will be invalidated.

Senior AP Exam Early Release or Late Arrival

- Seniors who wish to leave early or arrive late on an AP exam day must complete the following form by Monday, April 29th:
 - Senior AP Exam Tardy/Early Dismissal Form May 2025
- Eligible students will receive early dismissal from a proctor at the end of their AP exam. This option is available only for seniors who do not have 15 or more total absences.
