HOPE will be removed once segment 1 is completed online and proper notification has been made to the guidance department. Taking HOPE online does not guarantee placement in the student's next prioritized elective.

- Students will receive a copy of their schedule in homeroom.



# Rising 9th Grade Residency Verification



- Residency verification begins April 4th for the 2019-2020 school year.
   (expect to hear something by this date.)
- All rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders must show proof of residency.
   (this includes academy students)
- Students that are not verified will **not** be provided a high school schedule
- June or prior (documents go to Middle School)
- July or after (documents go to High School)
- 2 (required) + 1 (additional) = 3 (total records)
