Link Crew is a high school transition program that welcomes freshmen and makes them feel more comfortable throughout their first year of high school. Built on the belief that students can help other students succeed, Link Crew trains mentors from rising junior and senior classes to be Link Crew Leaders for the following school year. As positive role models, Link Crew Leaders are mentors and student leaders who guide freshmen to discover what it takes to be successful during the transition to high school and throughout their freshman year. **Link Crew leader applicants should not have 5 or more unexcused absences or any referrals.**

- **Freshman Day:** Thursday, **July 31st**, 7:30 am – 1:00 pm in the gym
- **Orientation:** Friday, **August 8th**, 9:00am – 11:00 am
- **First day of school:** Monday, **August 11th**; wear Link Crew Leader shirt. Help freshmen with directions, lockers, and questions.
- **Various other Link Crew service projects:** Must participate in at least 3 additional Link Crew service projects throughout the year.
