To ensure an optimal testing environment, we will allow flexibility to students on this day. High school students who are not participating in the PSAT may complete assigned work from home. Students that are not taking the PSAT and come to school will stay in the auditorium to work on schoolwork all day. Assigned work will be due on Thursday, October 23, the day after the exam. If you would like your student to be able to check out after the exam, please use the following link by Sunday 10/19: CLICK HERE

The student will be issued an early dismissal pass on the day of testing, so they can leave school after the school is done testing. Parents will pick their student up in parent pickup. Walkers, bikers, and student drivers who have an early dismissal pass may leave as if it is the end of the school day after the school is done testing.
