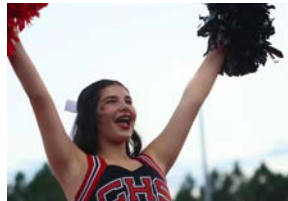

- Approved School Access ensures the safety of our students, faculty/staff, and our campus. All visitors and volunteers must have school access. ALL Volunteers must have school access to enter the school beyond the front desk would you ever:

2026–2027 Creekside Student Parking

2026–2027 CHS student parking is going paperless. On MAY 11th SchoolPay will be available and the instructions below will go out on ParentSquare.

2026–2027 Creekside Parking Permits

We ran out of student parking spaces during the last three school years. So, you should take care of parking in May. We don't have any guarantees that parking will be available in August.


All Parking permits cost \$120 and are available only to seniors and juniors. To obtain your 2026–2027 parking pass, please follow these steps:

1. Purchase your 2026–2027 parking pass via SchoolPay (click [here](#)).
2. In ParentSquare, upload the required copies – student's driver's license, vehicle registration, and vehicle insurance. If you are not sure of the vehicle yet, check "No." (Return to ParentSquare when you confirm a vehicle, and fill out the vehicle information.)
3. In ParentSquare, confirm that the student driver and guardian have read the [2026–2027 Creekside High School Parking Rules](#) (click here). Students can use a learner's permit now and then upload the driver's license later. Even if you won't be driving until later in the school year, you should take care of getting your parking permit now.

Student drivers will pick up their parking passes in the Courtyard during Meet the Teacher Day (August 6th or 7th) or during their lunch beginning on August 10th. Students will show their school ID or driver's license to pick up their parking pass.

Top 50 parking spots will be based on the most current senior weighted GPA ranking.

Greetings from the Cafeteria! As we arrive back from Spring break and head through the final quarter of this school year, we wanted to send out information for the remainder of the year.

Please note that if you have students who will be moving up to Creekside from a middle or K-8 school next year, please be aware that any special instructions with regard to your student and that schools cafeteria does not transfer with your student. The only thing that will carry over is any debt that has accumulated while within the St. Johns County School District. If there are restrictions on their buying, or food allergies, please be sure to communicate with our cafeteria so that we can address any specific issues.

Parents of Seniors!

Please be advised of the following information with regard to your graduating senior and his/her lunch accounts:

If you have a Paypams account for your student, and you have it set up to refill automatically, please be sure to stop the automatic payment option!

In addition, if your graduating senior has money left in his/her lunch account, please be aware of how to settle any balance left in their lunch account:

If there is a sibling in the St Johns County School District, the balance of money can be transferred to the siblings' lunch account. To have the balance transferred to a sibling, please click on this link: [SJCSD Food and Nutrition Services Cafeteria](#)

You can request a refund check for the balance of money in the account. Please limit refund requests for amounts over \$10. For

balances less than that, have your student make some last minute purchases. If you are seeking a refund of the balance in the account, please click on this link: [SJCSD Food and Nutrition Services Cafeteria Prepayment Refund or Transfer Request](#)

Lastly, in preparation for graduation, the seniors will receive a checklist of items to satisfy before the end of the school year and any debt owed to the cafeteria will be included in that list. If your senior has a negative lunch account balance, and you are paying the debt by check, a separate check needs to be sent in for the cafeteria. The cafeteria debt cannot be combined with any other school debt owed by the student. Alternatively, the debt can also be paid via credit card through Paypams, or by cash, in person, in the cafeteria. As always, please check out the Cafeteria section of the website Creekside Cafeteria – Creekside High School for answers to many questions you may have regarding food service! Here at Creekside, the cashiers are giving your student their lunch account balance daily. If they are not passing on the information to you, parents and guardians may set up a free account with www.paypams.com to review student meal transactions.

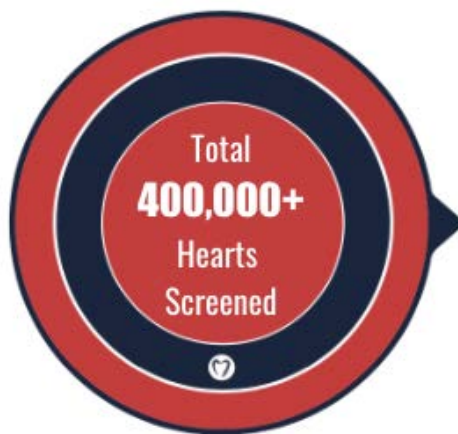
Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is the leading cause of death in student athletes and in the school system, most of which can be prevented.





Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is the leading cause of death in student athletes and in the school system, most of which can be prevented. **Electrocardiogram (ECG or EKG) heart screenings are now required prior to participation in Florida high school athletics** and Who We Play For (WWPF) is honored to screen children across the state and country.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL POLICIES FOR ATHLETES, BAND AND CLUB SPORTS

- Before and after school, athletes need to park in the student parking lot not in the faculty parking, bus parking, or in front of the stadium. For morning workouts, the gate closest to the bus loop and the stadium will remain open from 6:00 am – 8:45 am. All athletes must park in student parking unless it's a Saturday practice.
- Athletes here for training or morning workouts before the school day, please remain with your coach until 8:45 am. If you are here after school, remain with your coach until you are picked up.
- Modified and non-traditional athletes arriving to campus before dismissal, MUST park in the student parking lot (not in front of the stadium, bus parking or in faculty parking.) Student parking lot gates to access the practice fields will be open at 4:05 pm M, T, Th, F & 3:05pm on Wednesdays. (Athletes are NOT to jump the fence to access the practice fields (they may enter the practice fields by the gym if the parking lot gates are locked. Athletes MUST walk along the sidewalks and not in bus or teacher traffic exiting the school.
- Parents and all visiting teams may not access the back of the campus until all busses have departed and dismissal is completed which is at 4:25pm (M, Th, Th, F and 3:25 pm on Wednesdays.)

Athletic Registration is involved. It is more than getting a sports physical and uploading it. Four Videos need to be watched (Sudden Cardiac Arrest, Concussion, Heat Illness, & Sportsmanship) and many important forms regarding eligibility & compliance need to be read and digitally signed by both parent and athlete.

Let your families know that we have 29 sports and hundreds of registrations come in for each season for multiple sports and not to wait until the last minute because there is a chance of an athlete not being cleared.

The EL2 form MUST be on the one with a revision date of 7/25. Any other form will be denied. The EL2 form must be signed by a licensed Florida provider and must include their signature, stamp, address, or phone number.

Students & Parents MUST sign and date page 4. Most people miss this because it is in the middle of the page, and it looks like it is part of the doctor's information. RB will deny the physical if signatures are missing

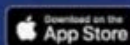
