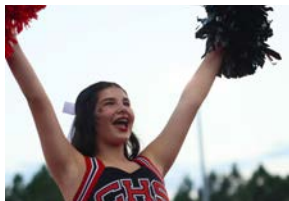
PARENT DROP OFF LINE: HELPFUL TIPS

Part-Time Program

- Local St. Johns County District teachers
 - Teachers have ability to visit students in person for support
 - Physical building (on campus of First Coast Technical College in St. Augustine) open 8am-4pm Monday-Friday for support
 - If need course reinstatement or help working with a teacher, SJVS admin can assist
 - Teachers help students complete so courses are added on time to graduate/promote
 - Placed in course with teacher in same day as request pending school counselor approval
- SJVS Registrar places courses on student schedule and transcript for zoned school

Flex Program

- Teachers located anywhere in the state of FL
- SJVS unable to place students in FLVS courses, length of wait time up to FLVS Registrar
- SJVS has no control over issues with FLVS teachers. Call FLVS helpline
- Zoned school registrar builds FLVS courses, taking longer to add courses to student schedule and transcript

What's the Same? St. Johns Virtual is a franchise of Florida Virtual, meaning we use the exact same platform and coursework as FLVS. The rigor, acceptability for college admissions, and policies for academic integrity are identical. Both schools allow students to take courses year-round



Student Registration Guide: Grades 6–12

1. Visit ar.flvs.net and click “New Students Start Here”
2. **Customize your catalog:**
 - Select Florida
 - Select your county

Browse through courses listed. Once you have found your course, click on the title to see more details, including prerequisites and course materials required.

 - Choose the semesters (1, 2, or Both)
 - If applicable, check the box verifying you meet noted prerequisites
 - Select your preferred start date
 - If applicable, select your county virtual school, **St. Johns Virtual School**
 - Click “Continue”
4. **Follow the prompts by selecting:**
 - Your main reason(s) for taking an SJVS course
 - If this course is on your physical school schedule
 - How you heard about SJVS
 - Click “Continue”
5. **Review My Backpack:**
 - Review course selected, including start date and semesters chosen
 - Click “Edit” to make changes or “Delete” to remove from My Backpack
 - To sign up for more, click “Add More Courses” and follow same process
 - Click “Continue”
6. **Create your account:**
 - Click “Create My Account”
 - Complete all the fields in the next screen(*Anything with an orange * must be filled in*)
 - Click “Sign Up”
 - *Write down your Username and Password*
7. **Complete your student information:**
 - Complete all the fields in the next screen (*Anything with an orange * must be filled in*)
 - Click “Next” when you complete each page
8. **Complete your parent/guardian information:**
 - Complete all the fields in the next screen (*Anything with an orange * must be filled in*)
 - Click “Next” when you complete each page
9. **Select your race/ethnicity:**

The Department of Education requires this information

 - Select appropriate boxes
 - Click “Next”
10. **Verify that all information is correct, and click “Continue”**
11. **Review the Student and Parent/Guardian Commitments:**
 - Check the appropriate boxes
 - Click “Submit”
12. **Complete your registration:**
 - To finalize registration and place you with an instructor, the following verification is required:
 - » Homeschool students: guardian verification
 - » Public students: guidance verification

The PSAT/NMSQT is an essential step in college preparation. It offers students the opportunity to experience a college readiness exam and helps identify those who may benefit from advanced coursework. The PSAT mirrors the [SAT](#) in structure, timing, and content, providing excellent practice while evaluating essential skills in Reading, Writing, and Math—key areas for success in college and beyond. Your student will also receive personalized feedback on their skills to help improve before taking the [SAT](#). For **Juniors**, the PSAT/NMSQT serves as the **qualifying exam for the National Merit Scholarship Program**.



10 SOPHOMORES

Sophomores will receive the PSAT at **no cost**, as the state fully funds it. There is **no need** for 10th-grade students to **register**.

9 11 FRESHMEN AND JUNIORS

Freshmen and Juniors **must register and pay a \$22 testing fee**. Registration must be completed online using the SchoolPay links provided below, **no later than midnight on Monday, September 14, 2025**. This deadline is firm due to the College Board's enforced policies for payment and registration in computer-based testing, **without exception**.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL POLICIES FOR ATHLETES, BAND AND CLUB SPORTS

- Before and after school, athletes need to park in the student parking lot not in the faculty parking, bus parking, or in front of the stadium. For morning workouts, the gate closest to the bus loop and the stadium will remain open from 6:00 am – 8:45 am. All athletes must park in student parking unless it's a Saturday practice.
- Athletes here for training or morning workouts before the school day, please remain with your coach until 8:45 am. If you are here after school, remain with your coach until you are picked up.
- Modified and non-traditional athletes arriving to campus before dismissal, MUST park in the student parking lot (not in front of the stadium, bus parking or in faculty parking.) Student parking lot gates to access the practice fields will be open at 4:05 pm M, T, Th, F & 3:05pm on Wednesdays. (Athletes are NOT to jump the fence to access the practice fields (they may enter the practice fields by the gym if the parking lot gates are locked. Athletes MUST walk along the sidewalks and not in bus or teacher traffic exiting the school.
- Parents and all visiting teams may not access the back of the campus until all busses have departed and dismissal is completed which is at 4:25pm (M, Th, Th, F and 3:25 pm on Wednesdays.)

MESSAGE](#), you have completed the online
process. But note, this DOES NOT mean your
student is cleared to participate.

6 Your Student is NOT CLEAR YET!

The data is electronically filed with
Creekside's Athletic Department for
review. When your athlete is cleared for
participation, you will receive an email
notification stating THEY ARE CLEARED.

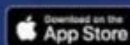
